Note:

1. Regular classes must be held from Monday to Friday (from 09:30 a.m. to 03:00 p.m) and 09:30 a.m.- 12:00 noon on Saturdays
2. Activities on Saturday must be organized after 3 regular periods. (Afternoon). Friday would be Intra-departmental competitions from 3:00 p.m. and Saturday Inter-departmental Competitions
3. Unit tests must be conducted after the completion of each unit.
4. Presentation after the completion of each unit by all students.
5. Pre-university examination must be conducted after the completion of the syllabus.

6. Minimum 3 Guest Lectures in each semester must be organized in each department.
7. Each department must organize a National Seminar in each semester.
8. Placement preparation classes / Mock Interviews/GDs must be organized for final year students.
9. PDP, Sports, Yoga, Library, and music classes must be placed in the timetable of all the departments.
10. Peer Review classes must be held in all departments once a week from 03:00 p.m. to 04:00 p.m.
11. Industrial Visit/ internship must be organized as per the requirement of the respective programmes.
12. Final Presentation (Inter-Department Competition) must be organized after the completion of the syllabus.
13. At the end of the 4th Sem, students have to attend 45-dayhands-on experience program (Summer Training)
14. At the end of the course or in the last semester, students have to undergo an Internship that may be arranged by the College or the student.
15. Excursions/ field trips must be organized once a year.
16. A schedule for VAC must be prepared by all the departments.
